Dried and Preserved Products*

A Note on Dried vs Preserved Products*:

Dried and preserved products both last a long time, but are different products. A **dried** product loses its moisture naturally to take on a muted 'antique' look; **preserved** products undergo treatment by harsh chemicals in order to bleach, colour and ensure their longevity. Preserved products are mostly imported and so attract a premium price-tag.
